

# NRC RAT Long Gong

## MATCH OVERVIEW:

The Match is a competition for .22 caliber rimfire rifles using ReActive steel Targets at 208 yards.

## SCHEDULE:

The range opens at 9:00AM. Shooters should arrive by 9:00AM for target setup and check in.

Firing starts at 9:30AM. Shooters will complete all stages per instruction below.

## RULES:

All shooting is from designated benches on the 200 yard range.  
There will be teams of 2 alternating shooting and spotting.  
If you do not have a partner, just show up and we will pair you up with someone.

## COURSE OF FIRE:

There are 3 to 4 steel plates set at 208 yards.  
Plates are 8", 6", 4", and possibly 2"

Shooter must shoot the largest plate first. If shooter hits that plate, they can either shoot the same plate again, or move to the next smaller plate.  
Anytime a shooter misses a plate, they must move back to the next larger plate.

8" Plate is worth 1 point  
6" Plate is worth 2 points  
4" Plate is worth 3 points  
2" Plate is worth 5 points.

Shooters will have 6 minutes to fire 15 shots. Goal is to get the highest score possible following the rules set above.

There will be 2-4 15 shot strings to make up a match.

## SHOOTER CATEGORIES:

For the small steel plates that are used, this is a 22LR rimfire only shoot. No HMR or 22 Magnum.

## BENCHES:

Shooters shoot from bench positions.
